THE PORCELAIN PEARL | 20 HOURS

INTRODUCTION

A complex and complete course to make the artist independent of creating large and small series of pearls for jewelery in various shapes, sizes and decorations.

Creation of porcelain pearls starting from a mold, tests of slip and body porcelain with the molds, construction with the techniques of Agata and Mosaic with pigmented body porcelain, construction of supports for decorating and firing the pearls.

Brush decoration using pigments and medium. Decoration with glazing immersion with different types of glazes. Use of single firing and bi-firing.

PROGRAM

DAY 01 03/04 7 hours 9.00-17.00	Preparation of the place and the materials necessary for use of the mold; Preparation and use of slip porcelain, precautions for slip casting and removing the piece of the mold; Use of the mold with body porcelain, precautions and corrections; Preparation of pigmented porcelain mixes, percentages; Preparation of Agate and Mosaic; Use of two techniques of pigmented porcelain inside the molds, construction of pearls; Mold drying; Finishing the first pearls, drying and half in the kiln; Biscuit firing;
DAY 02 04/04 7 hours 9.00-17.00	Preparation of colours to decorate with a brush; Preparation of glazes; Possible modifications; Opening the kiln; Cleaning and finishing of biscuit pieces; Methods of decorating pearls with pigments, etc; Varied techniques for surface treatment and texture; Drying and firing avoiding deformations; Glazing on raw pieces and on biscuit pieces, varied practical and fast glazing methods; Preparation of transparent, opaque or glossy and pigmented glazes; Methods of construction of the supports for decorating and for half in the kiln; Methods of firing the pearls avoiding deformations, breaks and mistakes; High temperature firing;
DAY 03 05/04 6 hours 9.00-16.00	Theory of the use of molds and materials for use with mould, both, slip casting and hand press body clay, both low and high temperature; Theory and application of firing curves; Materials theory; All possible precautions to avoid problems in the conformation of the pearls; All features for glazing and decoration;
