Reproducing a shape for large or small productions, but also creating unique objects from a casting or hand-moulding mould, simplifying the working processes; this is the dream of many ceramists.

Trainer Marco Malavolti will present in an effective, simple and creative way an intensive programme on the basic techniques required to make multi-part casting and pressure moulds.

Participants will work on objects provided by the organisation on which the moulds will be made. The objects are designed to see different complexities and moulding techniques.

The lessons are entirely practical in addition to a theoretical chapter related to techniques and materials and a FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) session.
